Workshops

Financial Coaching

Work with a volunteer financial coach who will help you achieve the financial goals you personally select for yourself.

One-on-One Sessions

Meet with one of our financial educators to assess your personal financial situation and set goals for the future. . Sessions are free and cover basic money management issues.



Tax Assistance

Have your taxes (including Homestead) prepared for FREE at the Richard Dilly Tax Center every year from late January-April 15th.

Get Checking Education

Rebuild your checking account relationship with a local bank or credit union. This workshop is designed for people who currently do not have an account with a financial institution or have had a problem with an account in the past.
